

The tall fescue and cocksfoot can provide good production into summer when moisture is available. All grasses contain no harmful endophytes for horses.

Long term hardy horse pasture blend that contains species that can tolerate drier conditions and hard grazing including prairie grass, cocksfoot, brome grass and browntop. Slower out of the ground that other equine pasture blends, but is very persistent once established

FESCUE EQUINE BLEND



A hard wearing perennial multi species blend that produces a uniform supply of grazing throughout the growing season. Improved leaf softness in the tall fescue over other traditional cultivars increases palatability, and a reduced aftermath heading increases quality.

- Red Clover
- Strawberry Clover

TURF EQUINE BLEND

A fast establishing grass pasture for horses that is animal safe with low endophyte levels to reduce grazing risks and good recovery from wear.

With vigorous grasses that establish quickly, this blend can be ideal for heavy traffic areas.
