DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Apply at higher rate during periods of increased physiological plant stress.

| CROPS | RATE | COMMENTS |
|-----------------------|--------------|--|
| TREES, NUTS AND VINES | 3 to 10L/ha* | Apply at a water rate of 400 to 1000L/ha. Apply from petal fall through until 20 days before harvest. |
| VEGETABLES | 3 to 10L/ha* | Apply at a water rate of 300 to 500L/ha. Apply from flowering through to harvest. |
| PASTURE | 3 to 10L/ha* | Use 3-6 applications over the growing season. Spray only when soil moisture is adequate. More than 4 applications should be used on irrigated pasture. |
| POTATOES | 3 to 10L/ha* | Use 2-3 applications over tuber set to increase tuber numbers. Use 1-2 applications two to four weeks before harvest to increase yield. |

*Use 3 to 4 L/ha for crop health maintenance.

Use 5 to 7 L/ha during periods of high physiological activity e.g. fruit set.

Use 8 to 10 L/ha for recovery from high stress events e.g. heat or chill.
